By the year 2000 it had grown to a size requiring incorporation, and it became the legal entity now known as Edgar Cayce Canada, a non profit organization. The organization is operated entirely by volunteers pursuing their passion for making information available to seekers in Canada, and its many programs are funded and sustained by the generous financial and in-kind support of its members. Edgar Cayce was able to enter a self-induced trancelike state that enabled him to place his mind in contact with an unlimited source of information. He left us a wealth of material in the transcripts of over 14,000 of his "readings." These readings cover hundreds of topics, including health and healing, finding your life purpose, spiritual growth and development, creativity, world events, relationships, dreams and service.



In 1931, Edgar Cayce with friends founded the *Association for Research and Enlightenment* which is an international, non-profit, non-sectarian membership organization headquartered in Virginia Beach, Virginia, with members in 80 countries and 37 International Centres around the world. Its mission is to promote the dissemination, study and application of the information contained in the psychic readings of Edgar Cayce.

For Kingston area residents a meals-only package (no accommodation) is available, but it must be arranged with the registrar by April 29th.

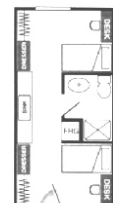
